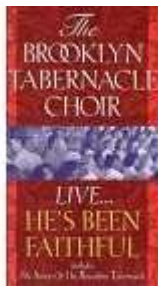
## PRAY FOR IMPACT OF THE TRUTH PROJECT IN UTAH
